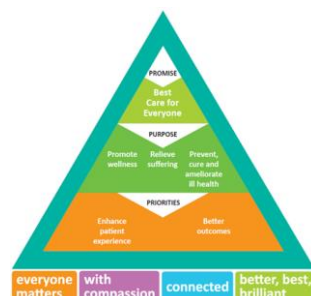

- **Efficient** and organised

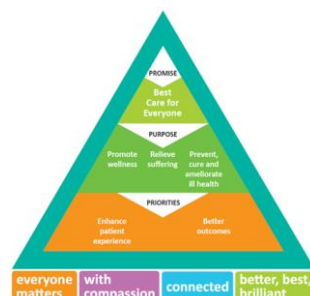

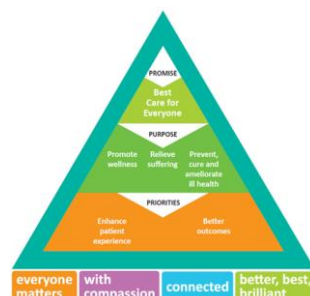
1. **What was the Māori health outcome you set out to improve** and why did you choose this outcome?
