



National strike action

Non-urgent X-rays, CT scans, MRI scans and angiograms will not be available from 7am on Monday, 26 August to 7am on Tuesday, 27 August due to a national strike by Medical Imaging Technologists (MITs) who belong to the APEX union.

What you need to know:

- **anyone with a condition that is not acute should contact their GP or visit an urgent care clinic during the strike period**
- **we will communicate directly with any patient whose appointment or elective surgery is affected - anyone not contacted directly by us regarding a postponement of their appointment during the national strike period should still attend as originally scheduled**
- **normal services will resume on Tuesday, 27 August at 7am**
- **maternity and birthing services (ultrasounds) are not affected.**
