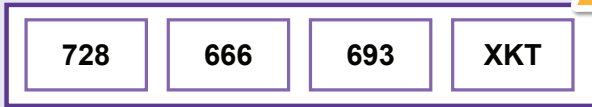
Census day is **Tuesday, 6 March 2018.**
