

Which toothpaste should you use?

The Ministry of Health recommends that children of <u>all ages</u> should use a fluoride toothpaste containing at least 1000 parts per million (ppm) fluoride*

*1000ppm fluoride is equal to 0.22% sodium fluoride or 0.76% sodium monofluorophosphate

How much fluoride toothpaste should you use?

0-4 year olds 5 years & older

These toothpastes contain the adequate amount of fluoride to help keep your child's teeth healthy



















These toothpastes <u>DO NOT</u> meet the Ministry of Health guidelines

These toothpastes contain little or no fluoride and are **NOT** as effective at helping to prevent tooth decay as toothpaste containing at least 1000ppm fluoride.
