Vaccination options on the Hibiscus Coast this weekend

The Hibiscus Boating Club pop-up vaccination centre returns this weekend, alongside a new pop-up vaccination centre at the Ōrewa Surf Lifesaving Club.

Waitematā DHB will be offering COVID-19 vaccinations at both sites, details are as follows:

- Ōrewa Surf Life Saving Club Saturday, 30 October to Sunday, 31 October, from 8.30am-3pm
- Hibiscus Coast Boating Club Friday, 29 October and Sunday, 31 October, from 9am-2.45pm

No appointments are necessary. However, anyone who would prefer to book can still do so online at bookmyvaccine.nz.

Waitematā DHB COVID-19 Executive Lead Tamzin Brott says the DHB is looking forward to returning to the boating club and opening a new pop-up centre in Ōrewa, too.

"The vaccination programme on the coast has been very well-received by its communities. Thanks again to everyone who has been vaccinated so far. We want to help keep the coast safe, so if you haven't had your first vaccination yet or you are due your second – please come and see us."

Waitematā DHB also operates a vaccination centre in Ōrewa and there are a number of GPs and pharmacies vaccinating people across the Hibiscus Coast.

There are 17 other community vaccination centres currently operating across metropolitan Auckland and appointments are not required at any of them.
