Your personal and health information

Collecting your information We will only collect necessary information such as: personal details e.g. age and address

- your medical history
- your family's medical history.

Information is collected to:

- identify you correctly
- assess, diagnose and treat you
- contribute to health research and advance health care
- share with other health care professionals
- For safety and protection, security cameras operate inside and outside the hospital.



Sharing your information

To provide you with appropriate treatment, we will share with and obtain information from:

- your general practitioner (GP)
- other health care professionals and providers involved in your care, such as rest homes, private hospitals, community health care providers and DHBs.

We may also share your information for:

- research and administrative purposes
- improving health outcomes for NZers
- Ministry of Health reporting
- informing your family, whānau and caregivers.

Your information will not be passed on to any other agency or person unless it is permitted or required by law.
