Thank you for your Official Information Act request received via partial transfer from the Ministry of Health on 22 February 2019 seeking the following of Waitemata District Health Board (DHB):

I would like a list of:

- current contract holders (providers) for each of the current DHB, ACC and MoH Home and Community Support Contracts
- current contract values
- contract terms and projected expiry/re-tender dates
- primary contact points within each funder for each contract

The table below provides the information requested on current Home and Community Support Services (HCSS) contract-holders (providers) and contract values using DHB expenditure for the 2017/18 financial year (1 July 2017 – 30 June 2018) rounded to the nearest \$1000. Please note Inbetween Travel (IBT) is excluded as this was paid separately via the Ministry of Health in 2017/18.

The HCSS contracts have a one-year term and are varied annually to extend the term and change the price. The DHB has not yet confirmed a timeframe for the re-tender for these services.
